PLANT

- Short stems (smaller than 50 cm)
- · Grovelling

LEAVES AND FLOWERS

- · Yellow flowers
- · Deep and smooth leaves
- Middle green leaves

CONSUMPTION AND NUTRITION

- Cooked in local dishes
- Leaves and flowers eaten for their mustard taste

CROP ADVICES

- · Direct sowing
- · Well ventilated and riched in organic soil
- · Well adapted to the different climate
