Wost Man Ecology's dry toilets are all based on the WM-Classic bowl in porcelain and have a separate bowl for urine at the front. It can be used without any water at all but normally the flush for the urine section is connected. The flushing has nothing to do with the primary function of the toilet but is invaluable for keep the toilet fresh and clean. On the whole this toilet gives the dry solution a touch of class.

The bowl can be bought separately and combined with your own or other systems already in use, for example different types of mull chambers. Traditional compost toilets always have problems with surplus liquid in the compost chamber. This gives a stinky mess very attractive for flies. An exchange of the old stool to a WM-Classic bowl will be a simple and cheap way to solve this problem.

Wost Man Ecology's own solutions are shown on the next page and are all based on the simple principle of separating wet and dry waste. In this way you gain many practical and technical advantages. By keeping the dry waste dry you avoid the risk of bad odour and flies. Urine is a resource that can be used as a fertiliser in your garden. The dry waste is easy to handle and can be emptied in an outdoor compost container along with other household waste. Check with your local Environment Committee if there are any special regulations about handling human waste.
